Operations Report Presented by Jim Green

- 1. All customers will have working meters by the end of May, 2024.
- 2. The water pump at the plant that pulls water in from the main line has died. Jim will replace it with a more durable pump.
- 3. The chlorine meters are still limping along.
- PFAS (Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances): Jim has tracked down a place that will test BCWD finished water for PFAS. The company is Environmental U.S.A. in Holland, Michigan. The cost of testing is \$550. Jim is awaiting results.
- 5. Jim will send regular test results to Marsha for inclusion on the website. We decided to wait until our July meeting to review PFAS results and decide how best to inform our customers of what is found and what actions might need to be taken.

Continuing Business

Marsha has made an initial application/inquiry to SIPA. They are reviewing our district profile. It may be necessary to find out about compliance with PDPA (Personal Data Protection Act).

Once we are approved by SIPA we will notify customers on the bottom of each bill.
